Participation criteria: Girls who have the skill to achieve a score of 122 strokes or less for 18H

Entry fee: 6,500 JPY (ex. tax) Play fee: 8,000 JPY (ex. tax)

- \*As a general rule, a parent or guardian (or equivalent) must accompany the player as a caddie and accompany the player on the round (by a golf cart). (The golf cart will be driven by the parent or guardian (or equivalent). A regular driver's license is required.)
- \* Players who make the cut will pay additional entry fee for Final round.

Entry fee (for Finals): 2,000 JPY (ex. tax)

\* Finalists will be selected through 18-hole stroke play, and will be announced on the day.

Girls: those with the skill to achieve a score of 116 strokes or less for 18H

Entry fee: 6,500 JPY (ex. tax) Play fee: 9,000 JPY (ex. tax)

\* Players who make the cut will pay additional entry fee for Final round.

Entry fee: 3,000 JPY (ex. tax)

\* \* Finalists will be selected through 18-hole stroke play, and will be announced on the day.

# Ages 15-17

< Qualifying Round > 18 holes stroke play

• Ages 15-17 division / boys and girls: August 5th (Tuesday)

Participation criteria:

Boys: Those with the skill to achieve a score of 94 strokes or less for 18H

Girls: Those who have the skill to achieve a score of 110 strokes or less for 18H

Entry fee: 6,500 JPY (ex. tax) Play fee: 9,000 JPY (ex. tax)

\* Players who make the cut will pay additional entry fee for Final round.

Entry fee: 4,000 JPY (ex. tax)

\* Finalists will be selected through 18-hole stroke play, and will be announced on the day.

(In the event of a tie for the transit slots, selection will be made using the matching scorecard method.)

- \* Play will be in a riding cart. (The guide will drive the cart.)
- \*The capacity may change depending on the situation.

<Final Round> 54 holes Stroke play \*Second cut after 36 holes (Aug. 07)

• Ages 15-17 division / boys and girls : August 6th (Wed), 7th (Thu) and 8th (Fri)

Entry fee: 6,500 JPY (ex. tax) \*players exempt from qualify round

Play fee: 9,000 JPY (ex. tax) / day

- \*If there are multiple players tied for first place, a hole-by-hole playoff will be held at a hole designated by the Competition Chairman to determine the winner.
- \* Play will be in a riding cart. (The guide will drive the cart.)
- \*The capacity may change depending on the situation.

## Designated practice days (seeded players)

- Ages 10-11 division: Mon, August 4th Play fee: 8,000 JPY (ex. tax)
- Ages 12-14 division: Wed, August 6th Play fee: 9,000 JPY (ex. tax)
- Ages 15-17 division: Tue, August 5th Play fee: 9,000 JPY (ex. tax)
- \* This designated practice session is only available to seeded players, players recommended by affiliated tournaments, and players specially recommended by the tournament.
- \*There are no designated practice days for players who have played qualifying round.

## <Competition Rules>

• Japan Golf Association (JGA) rules and special tournament rules will apply.

#### <Awards and Prizes>

- •1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners of each category will be awarded.
- •The awards ceremony will be held on the last day of the finals for each category, after the competition has finished.
- \* If there is a tie for first place after the regulation holes have been completed for each category (except for the Ages 6-7 and 8-9 divisions), a hole-by-hole playoff will be held on the same day at a hole designated by the competition chairman to determine the winner. If a playoff is held with three or more players, the players other than the winner will be tied for second place.
- \* In both the Ages 6-7 and 8-9 divisions, if there is a tie after completing the regulation holes, winnwr will be determined by the matching scorecard method.
- •Ages 15-17 division (boys and girls) will be a three-day (54 holes) competition that will be eligible for the R&A World Amateur Golf Rankings.
